NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS).
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 This Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions and the Class rules will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text shall prevail.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Regata is open for all 470 class yachts.
- 3.2 Each team is required to bring to the venue one of their national flag.
- 3.3 Registration of participants carried out the first day of regatta from 9:00AM till 10:00AM at Kaunas Jachtklub, M. Gimbutienės street 35, by submitting an application to race form or sending by email address info@470.lt

- 4.1 The entry fee is 40 LTL.

5.2 Regatta organizers reserve the right to change the race schedule and number of races.

5.3 May not be more than 4 races per day.

5.4 On Sunday no warning signal will be made after 14:00

5.5 Prize giving ceremony will start as soon as possible after the end of the protest time for the last race of last day.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

7 COURSES

7.1 Distance diagram will be displayed in supplements A or race instructions.

8 SCORING

8.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

8.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

9.1 All boats shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10 PRIZES

10.1 Regatta prizes will be awarded for first – third place winners.



11 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 11.2 The participant's coach or participant, if he has 18 years of age is responsible for boat preparation to race, including emergency equipment.
